


Genesis 3

Write some bad things that people do today. All these happen because of the sin inside people.






Bad Bad Cain


Sin was ruling everywhere now. The devil became happy because he thought he had succeeded in turning man against God. Little did he know that God had wonderful plans of rescue for man.


