determined to keep His promise of many years.


God's Instruction To Noah

Would you be a child who will accept God's offer of salvation through Jesus rather than be swept away by God's judgement like the people of Noah's days?


If your answer is YES, then bow your head to pray.


Noah's Ark Maze
